Voluntary Firearm Safekeeping Program

This service is to provide safe keeping of your firearm(s). Any surrendered firearm(s) shall be safely and securely stored at the Crawford County Sheriff's Office or Prairie du Chien Police Department in an air-conditioned location within the department. All surrendered firearms shall be received unloaded and cased. The firearm owner shall retain ownership of all surrendered firearms. The Crawford County Sheriff's Office or Prairie du Chien Police Department shall merely provide a safe location for them to be temporarily stored. The sheriff's office / police department does not assume any liability due to providing this service free of charge.

This contract is between the firearm owner and the Crawford County Sheriff's Office or the Prairie du Chien Police Department.

You, as the owner, are voluntarily turning over firearm(s) to the Crawford County Sheriff's Office or Prairie du Chien Police Department for safe keeping. Your firearm(s) will be stored for up to 1, 2 or 3 months at your discretion. Please specify:

At the end of the aforementioned length of time, you may contact the sheriff's office / police department and make arrangements to receive the firearm(s) being surrendered. If you wish the sheriff's office / police department to continue to hold your firearm(s), you may notify the sheriff's office / police department and sign a new agreement at that time. You may opt to receive your firearm(s) at any time prior to the original agreement by contacting the sheriff's office / police department to make those arrangements. The owner will need to pick-up the firearm(s) and sign that they have been taken back into the owner's possession.

If the owner chooses to permanently surrender any firearm(s) they shall notify the sheriff's office / police department in writing. Abandoned firearm(s) shall be destroyed per department policy. If the sheriff's office / police department does not have contact with the owner, and after reasonable attempts to contact the owner, the firearm(s) shall be considered abandoned after 12 months from the pick-up date on this agreement. By signing this contract, the firearm owner agrees that this contract and the actions taken by the Crawford County Sheriff's Office, or the Prairie du Chien Police Department as authorized by this contract shall not be deemed or construed as a violation of firearm owner's constitutional rights, and the firearm(s) owner waives he/her right to make such a claim against the Crawford County Sheriff's Office or Prairie du Chien Police Department.

Your name, weapon, or the fact it is being serviced here is confidential and private, except as necessary for federal licensing requirements or based on Federal Freedom of Information Act request(s).
